The lack of appropriate digital skills is a very important issue for many people today. The lack of skills does not concern access to technology, but the ability of young people entering the labour market to make intelligent and creative use of information and communication technologies so that they become active promoters of their careers in an increasingly digital world.

Many institutions are looking for ways to explore the level of digital competence and to identify areas that require more attention in learning and teaching. The IT Department of ZUT has joined the project "Digital Skills Accelerator (DSA)" together with partners from England, Belgium, Spain and Ireland. DSA is an international project with one goal: to implement and disseminate innovative solutions and good practices in education at different levels, including higher education.

A team of researchers has prepared a report in which they describe and analyse the level of digital competence in Poland, Spain, England and Ireland in relation to the DigComp Competence Framework developed by the European Commission. The most important products of the project are an on-line tool for testing one's digital skills and a set of solutions (curriculum, educational materials, e-learning materials), which are necessary for the improvement of digital competences.

The tools and report will be presented during a seminar which will take place on April 3rd , 2019 at the Faculty of Computer Science, 52 Żołnierska Street. The event will start at 10:30.

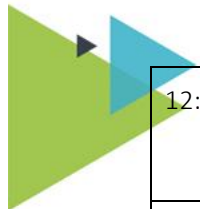
Each participant in the seminar will receive certificates of participation, and those of you who decide to test their digital competences will receive a report from the survey.
