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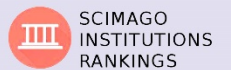


# Sumy State University

(founded in 1948)



- 15.000 students, 1600 international students from 50 countries, 9 English language programmes in IT, management, marketing, medicine, electronics
- 51 specialties with about 90 academic programmes from humanities and medicine to engineering and IT, 45 postgraduate and post-doctoral programmes
- Number of staff – more than 2000; 130 Doctors of Sciences, Professors; 660 PhDs, Associate Professors

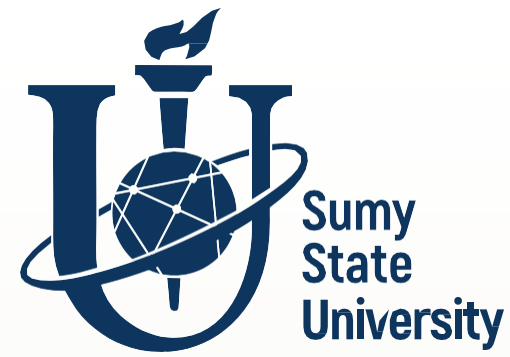

## Selection procedures

- Selection provided by the home university (in the majority of projects)
  1. Application documents to be submitted to the International Affairs Office
  2. Interview in English
  3. Meeting of the Selection Committee
  4. Selection by the home university
  5. Forwarding the application documents of the selected students to the host university
  6. Confirmation from the host university

Important! Be sure to have a list of the selected students and staff, and a reserve list as well.



## Selection procedures

- Selection provided by the host university
  1. Application documents to be submitted to both universities
  2. Nomination by the home university and selection by the host university

Important! Be sure to have a ranking list of the nominated students and staff.

# Challenges VS Recommendations

## Synergy of academic and administrative staff work:

- academic – categories, quotas, mobility content
- administrative – documentation, recognition, deadlines

## Clear agreements of partners before launching mobility:

- on matching schedules
- on lists of courses/modules offered and recognition procedures
- on language proficiency and other selection criteria

## Provisions for open access and transparent selection:

- effective set of tools for wide dissemination
- extended selection committees, including students

# Challenges VS Recommendations

## Focus on the incoming mobility:

- design of attractive programmes/modules in foreign languages
- supporting services (adaptation, accommodation, mentoring)

## Thorough monitoring of on-going mobilities:

- regular meetings and collection of feedback
- evaluation of learning/training progress

## Creation of Erasmus community:

- programme alumni
- platform for communication (forum, website, social nets)
