Blended mobility objectives

- New and more flexible mobility formats– either on bilateral basis or through blended intensive programmes
- Fostering innovative ways of learning and teaching
- Reach to all types of students in all study fields and cycles (short cycle, bachelor, master and doctoral levels)
- Encourage collaborative online international learnings (COILs)

Blended intensive programmes

- Develop short, intensive and joint blended mobility curricula and activities
- Both for students and academic and administrative staff
- Short-term physical group mobility abroad (5-30 days) combined with a compulsory virtual component
- **Minimum 3 HEIs** from 3 programme countries
- **Minimum 15** participants
- **Minimum 3 ECTS credits** for students



Doctoral mobility

- Short-term studies or traineeships abroad (5-30 days) in addition to the long term mobility (2 to 12 months):
- Virtual component optional
- More flexibility and better tailored mobility periods
- Opportunities for doctoral candidates further highlighted
- E.g. highlighted that post-docs can do traineeships

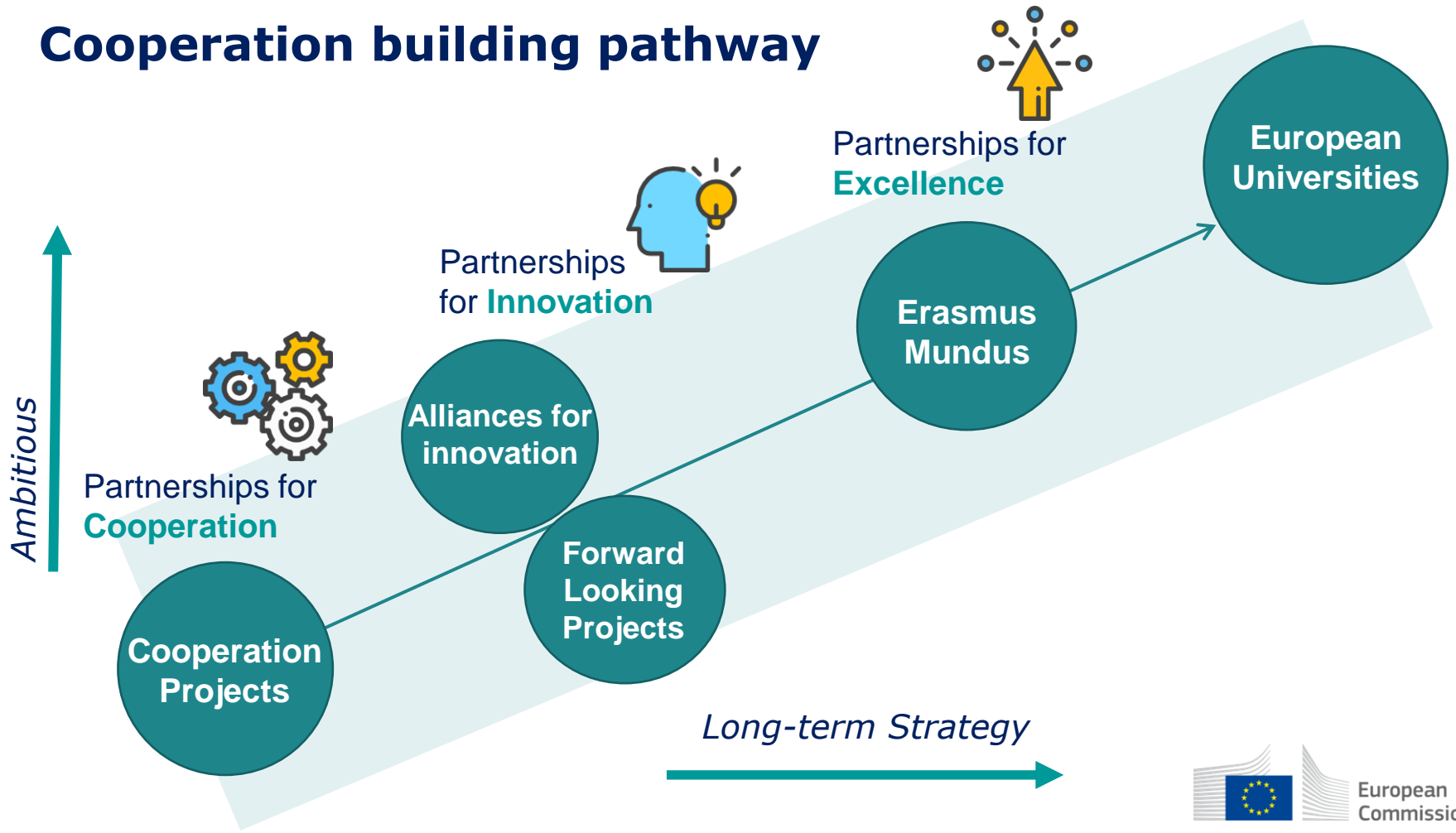

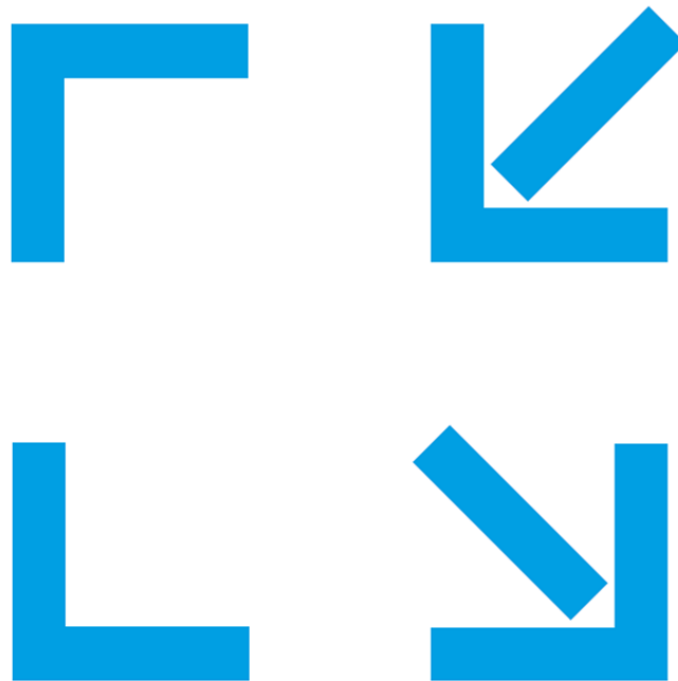

Digital Inter-institutional Agreements

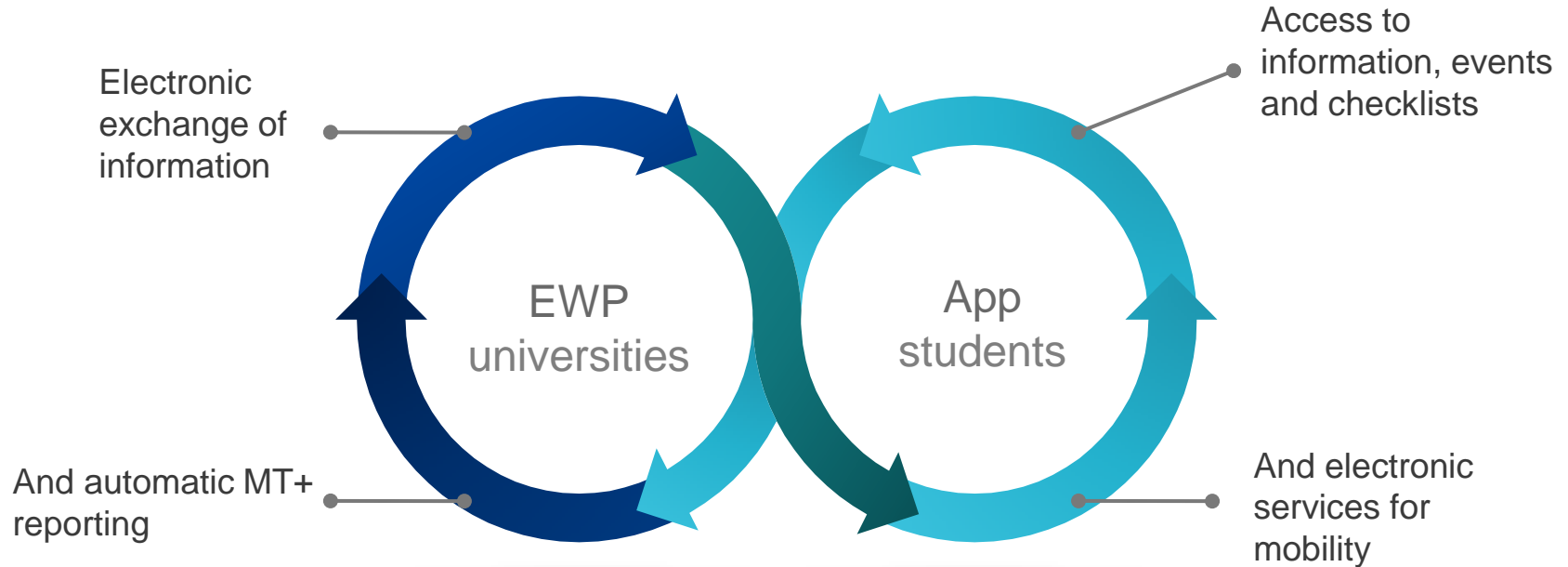
- Extended testing period ended on 15 October

 - Transition phase - current agreements valid for Call 2021
 - Digital Agreements ready before Call 2022 mobilities
